Master of Philosophy (MPhil) & Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in Management Programs

KUSOM's MPhil and PhD in Management are research degree programs that offer a student with substantial grounding in state-of-the-art academic knowledge in management with advanced research skills.

Eligibility MPhil

Nepali and non-Nepali nationals with:

- A Master's degree in management- related disciplines (including business management, general management, development management and other functional, sectoral or policy management fields); Master's degree in engineering, physics, mathematics, statistics or economics-related disciplines; or Master's degree in selected social sciences disciplines from the universities recognized by Kathmandu University;*
- Minimum CGPA of 3.25 on a scale of 4.0 or 60 percent in the Master degree; and
- Strong quantitative background in graduate and undergraduate level; research aptitude and commitment.

*Selected candidates from non-management backgrounds may require to take some pre-requisite graduate level courses as specified by the School prior to or concurrent with the prescribed MPhil courses.

PhD

Nepali and non-Nepali nationals with:

- A research-oriented Master's degree MPhil or MS by Research in Management or a Master degree** (in Management or Management Sciences or relevant Functional Management Disciplines; in Engineering, Economics, Mathematics, Psychology, Public Administration, Sciences, Sociology, Statistics) from the universities recognized by Kathmandu University;
- Minimum CGPA of 3.25 on a scale of 4.0 or 60 percent in aggregate; and
- One individual research proposal containing the prescribed components***.

**Candidates with a Master degree other than MPhil or MS by Research will need to take prerequisite courses equivalent to minimum 12 credits as decided by Research Committee before allowing to take PhD level course works.

Admission Applicants should appear for KUSOM's Management Research Aptitude Test (MRAT) on **Saturday, 02 September 2017**. Successful applicants will be called for further selection procedures.

The last date for the submission of completed Application Form and required documents is **Wednesday, 30 August 2017**.
